

DO YOU FEEL SAFE ON CAMPUS?

The SAFE Team is an on-campus escort program that provides members of the USF community a safer option to getting to their car or residence hall at night, free of charge. The SAFE Team also helps deter attempted crimes by patrolling the campus at night in their golf carts. If you ever feel uncomfortable walking alone at night, call (813) 974-SAFE for a safe escort to your destination.

The Advocacy Program will assist USF Students or employees who are victims of actual or threatened violence including assault, battery, sexual battery, or attempted sexual battery. Services are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. You can reach an on-call advocate by calling (813) 974-5757.

The University Police services include car patrol, foot patrol, bike patrol, criminal investigations of all misdemeanors and felonies, traffic enforcement, crash investigation, special events management, and crime prevention programs 24 hours a day, seven days a week. You can call (813) 974-2628 for general information. Always call 911 in the case of an emergency.
